In Japan, we have access to a wide variety of delicious food. However, there is a serious problem we need to face: food loss. Every year, an *enormous amount of food is wasted in homes, restaurants, and supermarkets. It is said that the amount of food loss in Japan is about 5 million tons every year. This is almost the same amount of rice that is produced in Japan in one year.

There are several reasons for this problem. One major reason is related to food *standards. Many fruits and vegetables are thrown away simply because they do not look perfect. They might be a strange shape or have a small mark on the skin. Another reason is our shopping habits. We often buy too much food, and it *expires before we can eat it all. Also, many people throw away *leftovers from their meals.

This waste has serious *consequences. It is a waste of the resources, such as water and land, used to produce the food. It also has a negative *impact on our environment. When food is thrown away in *landfills, it produces dangerous gases that *contribute to climate change.

We can all take small steps to solve this problem. For example, we should plan our meals and make a shopping list before going to the supermarket. This helps us to buy only what we need. Also, we can try to be more creative with our leftovers instead of just throwing them away. By being more *conscious of our food, we can help reduce waste and protect our planet.
